



50 50 CLUB WHAT IS THE 50 50 Club?

A monthly prize draw competition to help raise money for Friends of Knowl Hill

HOW DOES IT WORK?

It costs £1 for a single entry into the prize draw and you can invest in as many entries as you like. Upon entry you will be allocated a number for each £1 paid. You will retain that number throughout the period you choose to remain a member (minimum 12 months). A draw takes place every 3 calendar months.

There is no limit to how many numbers you can have, so why not buy some for yourself and someone in your family. And of course it goes without saying that the club is open to everyone; parents, extended family, family friends, carers, school staff and directors.

The club runs from **January to December** each year (although you can join for a part year)

WHAT HAPPENS TO MY £1?

Every £1 entry is divided up equally on a defined basis. Firstly 50% of your £1 is given directly to the PTA for purchases for Knowl Hill School. The remaining 50% is the prize money allocated to each monthly draw.

HOW CAN I ENTER?

Simply complete an entry form and return your completed form to the School office. The Friends of Knowl Hill run the 50 / 50 club on behalf of the school however hold no personal information off site. All personal information is stored in a locked cabinet at the school.

HOW DO I PAY?

By Standing Order – paying the full annual amount for the amount of numbers you have and complete both sections of the entry form, return the top part with your entry form to the school office and give the Mandate to your bank (or set-up it up on online banking). Once your payment has cleared, the 50 50 Treasurer will enter you into the next monthly draw. Please make your Cheque - payable to **The Friends of Knowl Hill**

Complete an entry form and return to the School office with your cheque. Minimum investment is 12 months.

Winners will be drawn every three months and notified directly. All winners' names will be posted on our Facebook page and website pages. Winners will receive their winning in the form of a cheque sent directly to them.

Club Rules

Jan 2019 – Dec 2019

- 1) The club shall be known as “Knowl Hill School 50/50 Club”.
- 2) The net proceeds after payment of prizes shall be donated to “The Friends of Knowl Hill’
- 3) The annual subscription for 1 share (number) shall be £12-00 per annum. Members may hold more than one share in a club year.
- 4) A new member may join part way through the club year. A pro-rata subscription will apply based on the number of remaining draws in the club year.
- 5) Each member shall be allocated a number for every share. Numbers will be allocated in numerical order and members will be informed of their allocated number(s).
- 6) Payments must be paid in advance and are not refundable.
- 7) The proposed number of shares is 100. If required this will be increased.
- 8) Any member whose subscription falls into arrears will forfeit membership.
- 9) The monthly draws will be made during school assembly and the winner notified via email.
- 10) Prize money will be 50% of the value of active subscriptions in the draw month.
- 11) August numbers will be drawn in July before the end of the academic year.
- 12) Participants must be at least 16 years of age. The decision of “The Friends of Knowl Hill’ shall be final in any matters requiring adjudication.
